Sole iOS engineer on a remote patient monitoring product: owned the codebase from initial commit to TestFlight, drove planning, estimation and scope with the cross-functional team, and translated protocol specifications from third-party medical device manufacturers into delivered features.

- Integrated **3 medical devices** (thermometer, pulse oximeter, 3-lead ECG recorder) over vendor SDKs, BLE GATT and serial-over-BLE, and modeled every reading as **FHIR** observation and device data resources.
- Implemented a proprietary ECG wire protocol in Swift from the manufacturer's specification with no vendor iOS SDK — binary command/ACK messaging and a real-time streaming decoder for 3-lead ECG, unit-tested against captured hex fixtures.
- Built a reusable **Core Bluetooth** connectivity layer over a generic **GATT** profile abstraction — read, write and notify behind one device-agnostic interface, fully testable without hardware, so each new device integration reused one proven connection path.
- Built an offline-durable delivery pipeline for patient measurements: an **SQLCipher**-encrypted local outbox feeding a **WebSocket** stream with checksummed chunks and a retry/backoff loop — at-least-once delivery across network drops and reconnects.
- Made **agentic coding** the primary development workflow, converging on **spec-driven** and **test-driven development** — 25 independently verifiable Swift packages that agents extend and tests validate before composition.
